Suburban North Alano Covid-19 Response Re-opening Plan Opening June 1, 2020

In cooperation with the loosening of the Governors executive orders from stay at home to stay safe, we are opening the building starting June 1 under the conditions listed below. Per the Governor’s office FAQ, as sobriety support meetings, we are grouped as a faith-based community, and as such, to the extent that we felt that we could, we have used the Guidance for Faith Based Community guidelines as the basis for our Covid response. We cannot guarantee that you will not get sick, but we can follow some simple guidelines that will improve our odds. Your cooperation is important to our shared health/safety.

Here is our plan:

1. Everyone should understand that you enter this facility at your own risk.
2. Meetings of 10 people or less per room up to max room capacity defined below.
3. Max room occupancy:

Room	1	2/3	4	5	Basement Auditorium	Basement Back Room	Kitchen	Picnic Tables
Max Occupancy	6	10	4	4	10	7	8	10 Total

4. Groups are encouraged to continue holding online meetings for those who cannot/should not, attend in person.
5. People in high risk categories are strongly encouraged to stay home and participate in online meetings.
6. People who are sick should stay home and participate in online meetings. See the CDC guidelines document.
7. Follow safe practices for disease management:
 - a. People should wear protective face masks
 - b. Practice safe distancing of 6 ft. or more between individuals
 - c. Cover your coughs and sneezes (you should be wearing a mask anyway)
 - d. Wash your hands often
 - e. Per the FAQ (see link above) from the state, “The consumption of food and beverages beyond what is necessary for a planned service or ritual is prohibited.”
8. Squad leaders are encouraged to work with other squad leaders (AA) and group leaders (Al-Anon, ACA, CODA) whose meetings overlap with yours to create gaps in start/end times, to allow for safe distancing when entering/exiting, and to allow time for disinfecting. Please contact Luke S. (701-261-5281) Board Squad Liaison if you need help contacting each other.
9. The board will attempt to provide hand sanitizer/surface disinfectant, and tissues in each of the bigger rooms and/or in the literature cupboard. Please notify the board right away if you are unable to find these items.
10. Please bring your own mask. The board will attempt to provide a supply of masks in the literature cupboard, please donate \$1 for each mask you use.
11. When you are finished using a room, please wipe down all touch points with disinfectant: the table surface, doorknobs, door frames, light switches, etc.
12. We are removing the box and standing fans. Please do not try to find them and use them. We will enable the old ventilation system upstairs that sucks air out through the ceiling vents.
